IT Technician

Farleigh School is seeking to appoint an experienced and forward-thinking IT Technician who will play a central role in maintaining, developing, and enhancing the school's IT environment. Working closely with the IT Manager and the Head of IT & Computing, the successful candidate will provide high-quality support to staff and pupils while contributing to system development and the continual improvement of the school's digital infrastructure.

The ideal candidate will:

- Bring a strong, demonstrable understanding of computer hardware, software, networks, and modern IT systems through previous hands-on experience
- Show commitment to ongoing professional development and emerging technologies
- Demonstrate excellent problem-solving skills and remain effective under pressure
- Possess strong planning and organisational skills with a flexible, proactive approach
- Communicate clearly and confidently with staff, pupils, and external partners
- Work successfully both independently and as part of a team
- Be self-motivated, able to prioritise effectively, and take initiative to improve systems and processes

Job Description: IT Technician

Responsible to: IT Manager & Head of IT & Computing

Particular Tasks & Responsibilities:

Technical Support & Service Delivery

- Respond promptly and professionally to support requests.
- Diagnose and troubleshoot hardware, software, and connectivity issues across a wide range of devices and platforms.
- Escalate complex or specialist tasks to the IT Manager or third party providers when appropriate, ensuring clear communication and follow up.
- Provide support for devices running Windows (client and server), macOS, and iPadOS.
- Support the effective use of classroom technology, including Promethean displays, projectors, and other AV equipment used for teaching and school events.
- Work under the direction of the Head of IT & Computing to support the use of technology in teaching and learning, assisting with the setup, preparation and maintenance of resources and equipment required across curriculum areas.

Device Deployment & Asset Management

- Oversee new device deployments, including rollout, configuration, and ongoing maintenance of the school's devices, including iPads, Macs, and PCs.
- Support device enrolment, compliance, configuration and updates through Jamf School and Microsoft Intune.
- Support the management of Apple School Manager, Automated Device Enrolment (ADE) and app deployment.
- Asset tag and record new equipment, keeping the asset database accurate and up to date.
- Ensure new and existing equipment is PAT tested in line with school procedures.

Systems Administration

- Create, manage, and maintain user accounts across multiple systems, ensuring correct access permissions and adherence to security best practice.
- Administer Microsoft 365 services, including user provisioning, access management, security controls and supporting core cloud applications.
- Monitor and report on backup processes, flagging any anomalies to the IT Manager.
- Maintain clear documentation of systems, procedures, and configurations.

Cyber Security & Safeguarding Support

- Support cyber-security practices including patching, security monitoring, MFA support, password management and ensuring good digital hygiene across the school.
- Assist with reviewing alerts from web filtering, firewall and safeguarding monitoring tools, escalating concerns to the DSL or relevant leads.
- Support the implementation of security policies and contribute to improving the school's overall security posture.

Process & Continuous Improvement

- Follow departmental processes and support their refinement, contributing ideas to strengthen efficiency, consistency, and service quality.
- Identify areas for improvement and proactively suggest solutions to technical or operational challenges.
- Maintain the IT storeroom, ensuring consumables and spare devices are organised and replenished.

Collaboration & Departmental Support

- Work effectively with external suppliers and service providers to support the school's IT operations.
- Deputise for the IT Manager when required, maintaining continuity of service and ensuring the smooth running of systems and workflows.
- Attend weekly planning meetings with the IT Manager to review progress and set goals

Infrastructure, Network & Systems Projects

- Support the IT Manager with tasks including:
- Installation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of wireless access points and network switches.
- Management of on premise servers (Hyper-V and associated storage).
- Configuration, management, and ongoing maintenance of the FortiGate firewall and web filtering systems.
- Administration and deployment of the school's telephone system.
- Contributing to departmental budgeting by monitoring spend and assisting with future planning.
